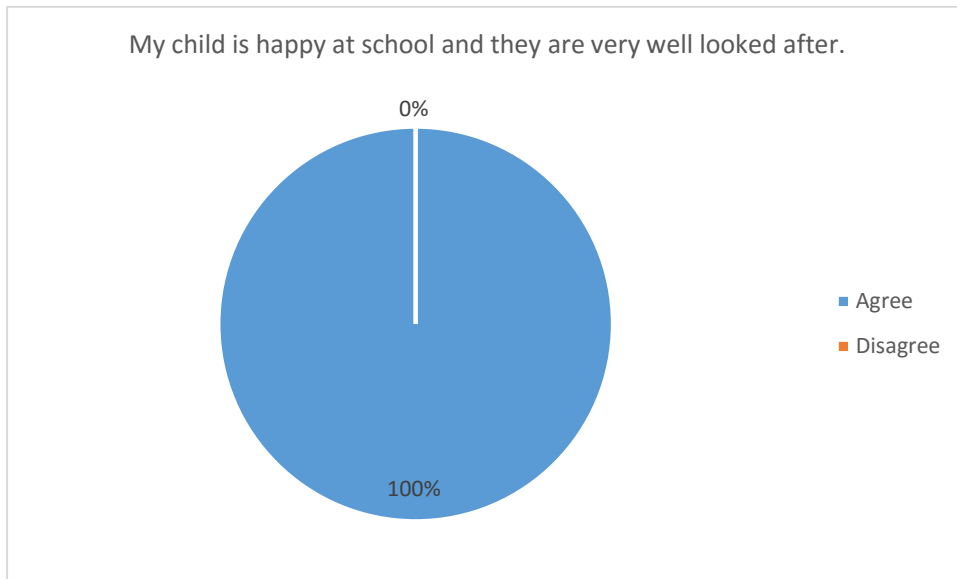


Pupil Questionnaire April 2017

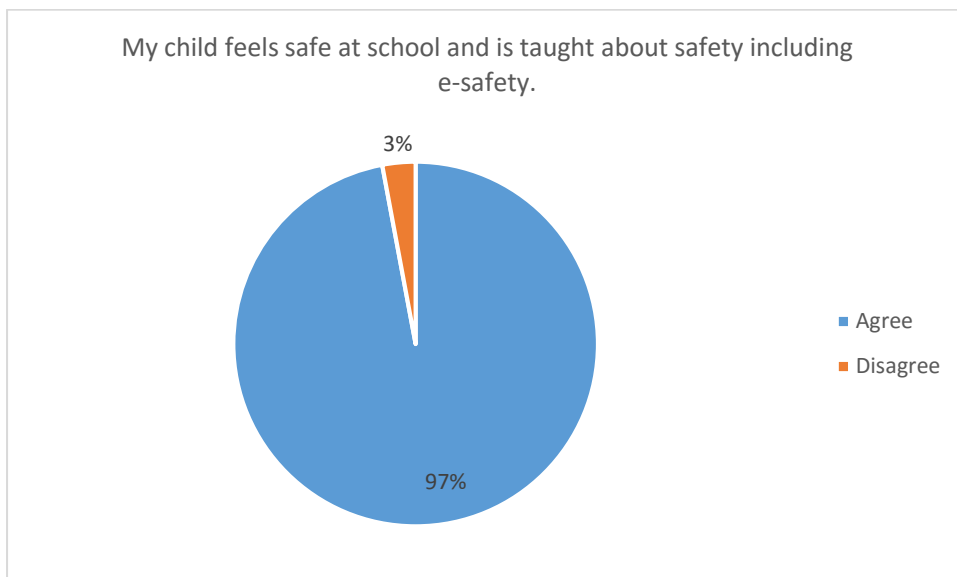
Q1. My child is happy at school and they are very well looked after.

18 out of 18 Agree



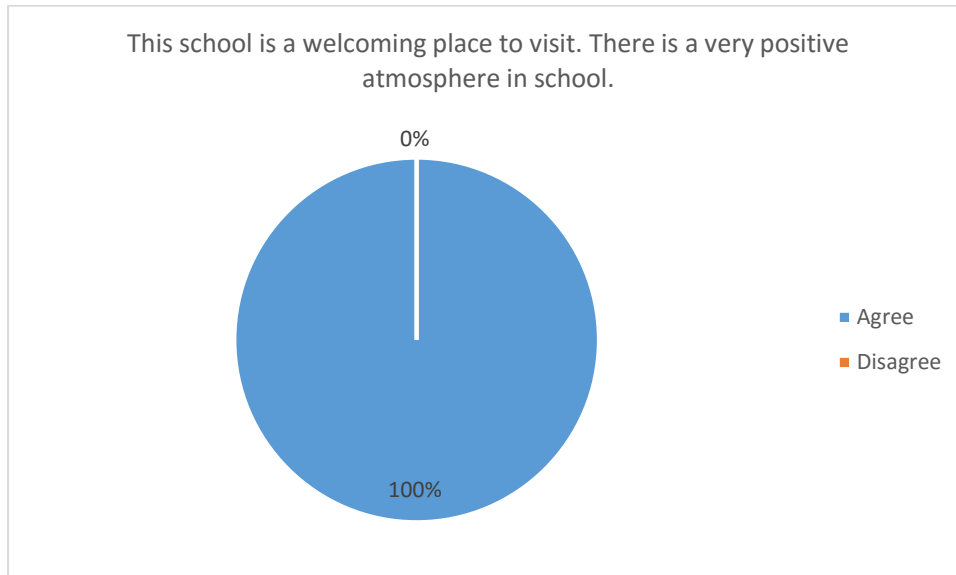
Q2. My child feels safe at school and is taught about safety including e-safety.

17 out of 18 agreed 1 person unsure



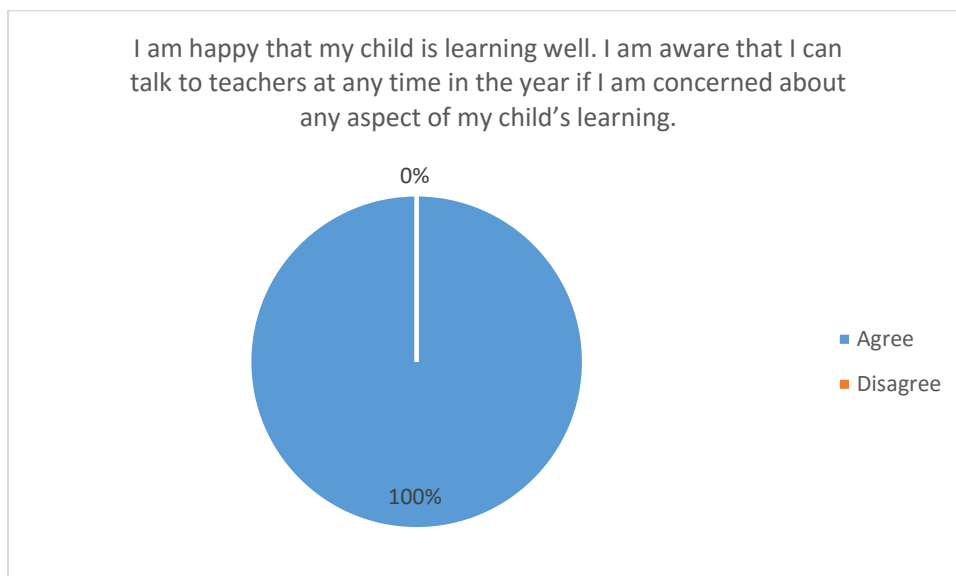
Q3. This school is a welcoming place to visit. There is a very positive atmosphere in school.

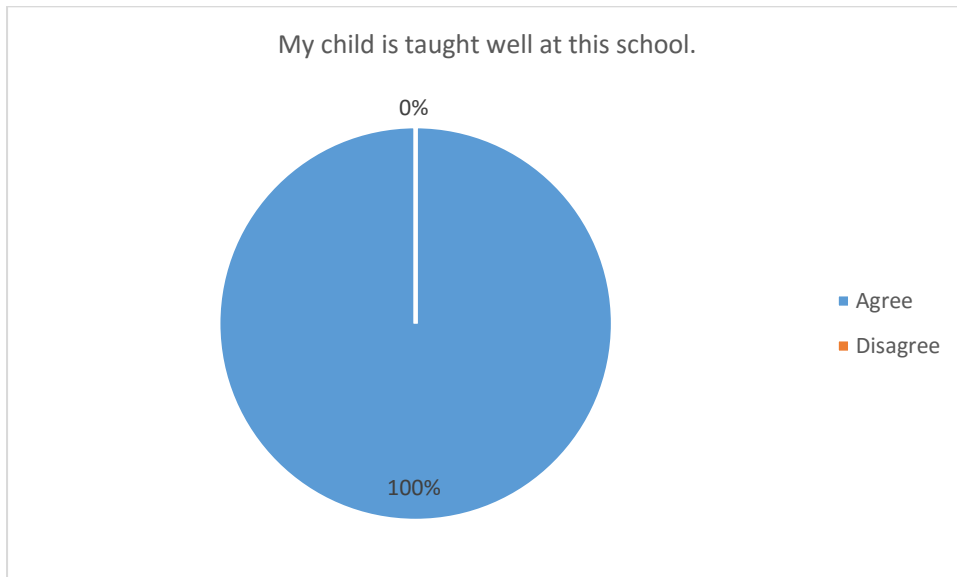
Q4. I am happy that my child is learning well. I am aware that I can talk to teachers at any time in the year if I am concerned about any aspect of my child's learning.

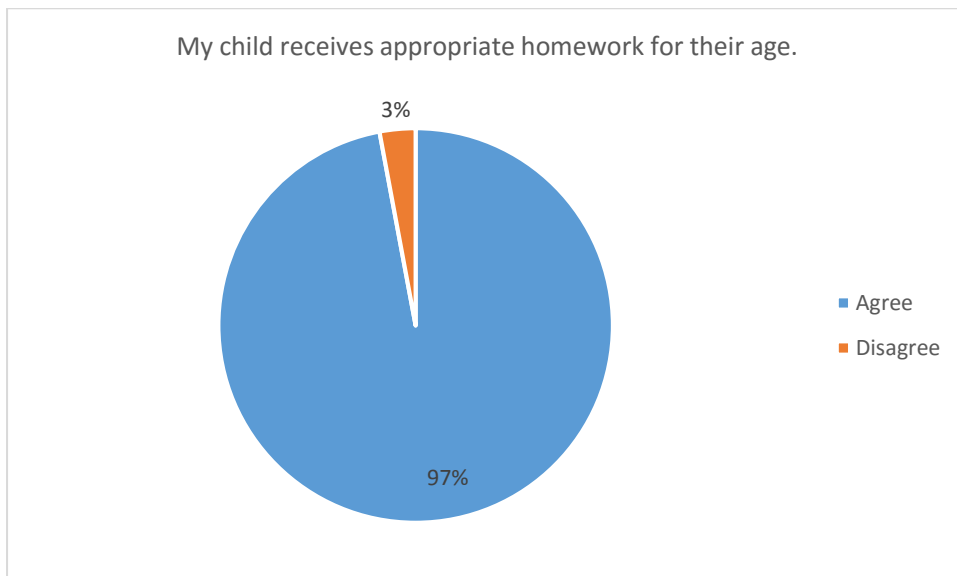
Q5. My child is taught well at this school.

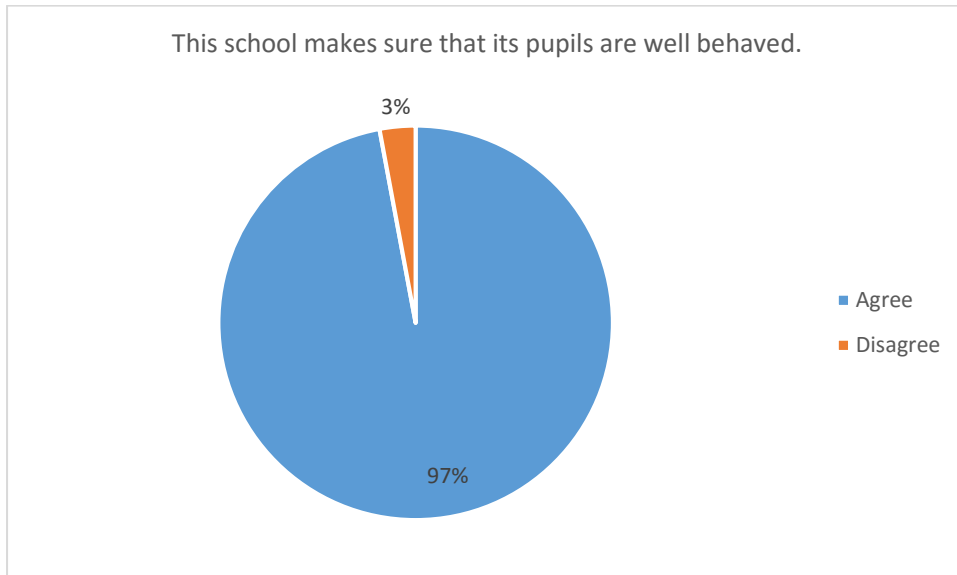
Q6. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.

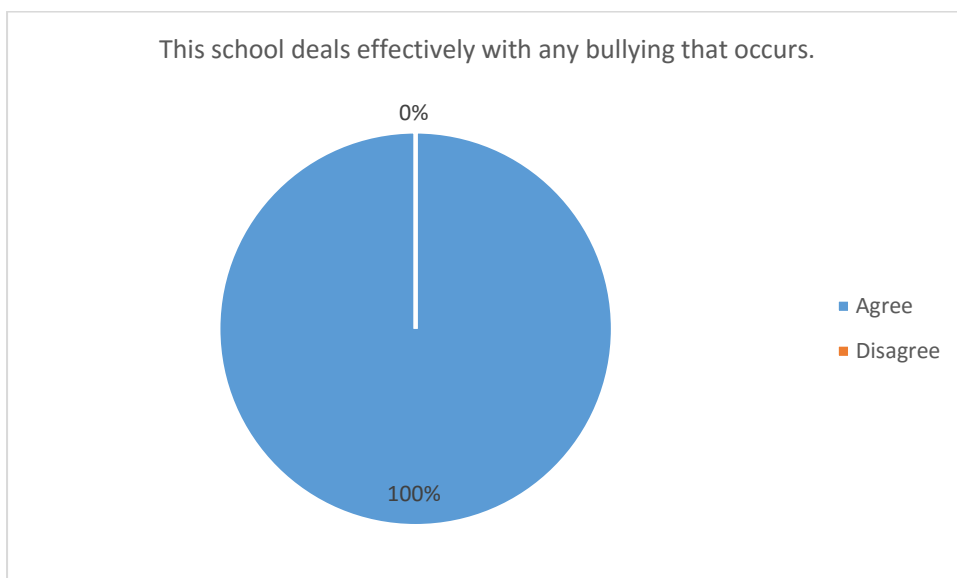
Q7. This school makes sure that its pupils are well behaved.

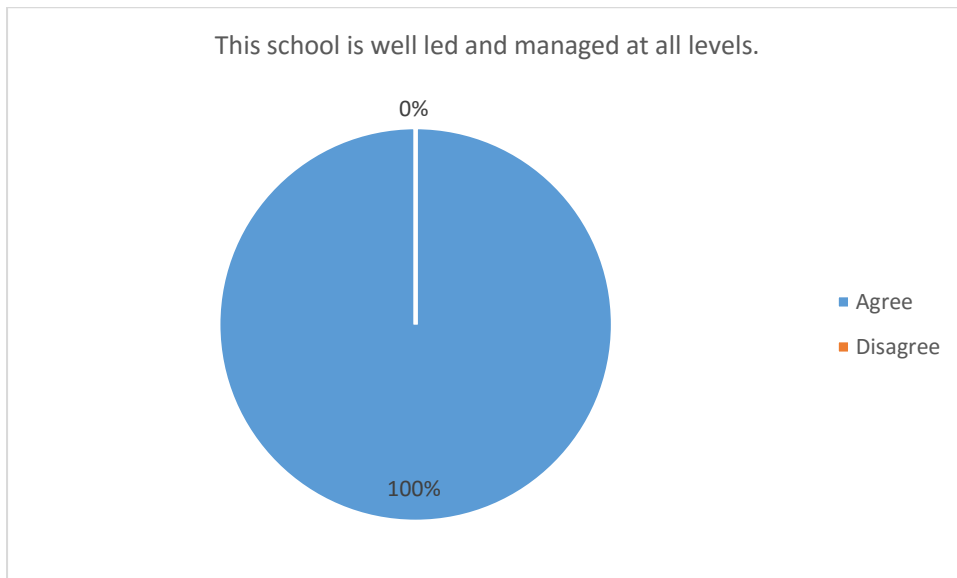
Q8. This school deals effectively with any bullying that occurs.

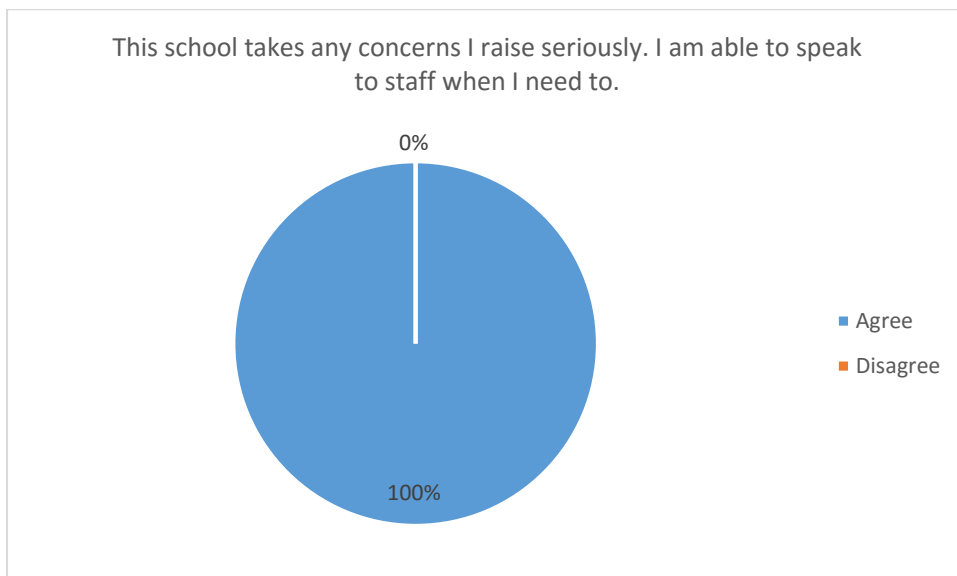
Q9. This school is well led and managed at all levels.

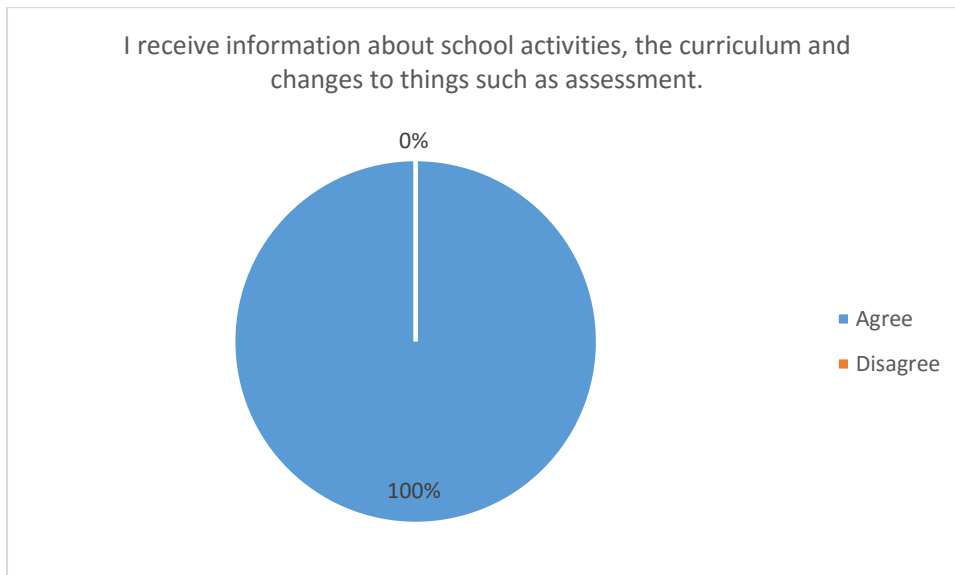
Q10. This school takes any concerns I raise seriously. I am able to speak to staff when I need to.

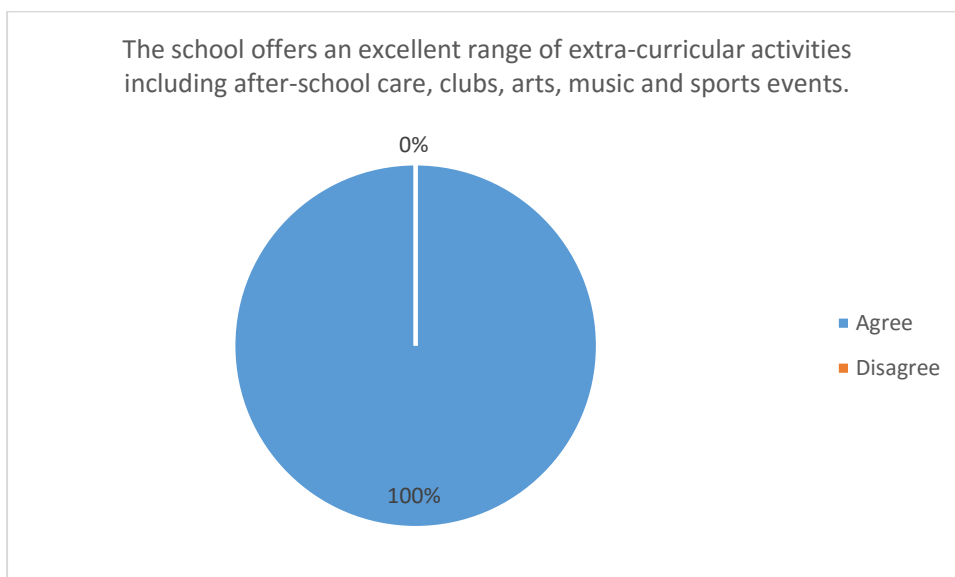
Q11. I receive information about school activities, the curriculum and changes to things such as assessment.

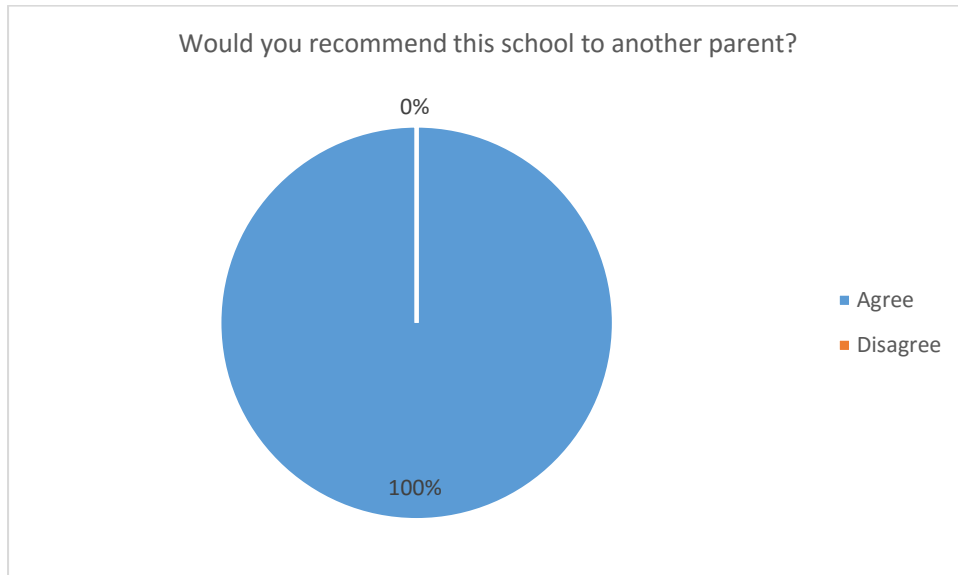
Q12. The school offers an excellent range of extra-curricular activities including after-school care, clubs, arts, music and sports events.

Is there anything that you would like to see improved?

Our parents said:

- Please consider an improvement to the uniform – could Year 5/6 wear a tie? A summer uniform for boys – white polo shirts are not practicable.
- Please consider PDF-writable documents for permission etc on website and email communication – please save paper
- I do fear funding cuts – what will happen in the next 5-10 years? What does this mean for parents and how can we address it proactively?
- Communication – could both parents receive text alerts?
- The amount of notice for events
- School uniforms can look scruffy – not a good image.
- Less paper, more email information especially for trips since we are often given good notice and the paper copy can go missing.
- Recruiting a school handyman – a local volunteer from the village to save school money and get community involvement
- New website is great – make sure it keeps updated
