Thank you to everyone who either spoke to him or who completed the 'Parent View' survey. Your views are taken very seriously by Ofsted in determining their lines of enquiry.

As soon as it is available it will be sent to parents and put on the website. Back Woods Camp for Class 1 on 21st June with Year 2 staying over night on 20th June.


Year 3 and 4 residential to the Yorkshire Dales along with Lindale School: Wed.5th – Fri. 7th June.
