The Charanga Musical School Scheme provides a practical, exploratory and child-led approach to musical learning. The interrelated dimensions of music weave through the units to encourage the development of musical skills as the learning progresses through listening and appraising, differing musical activities including creating and exploring and performing.

This is supported with weekly singing practise and school performances throughout the year e.g. Harvest, Christmas, Mother's Day, Easter, Leaver's concert.
