In science we will be learning about classification and then exploring 3D collage in Art.

The Discoverers started off this term with some Computing. We were using a program called Tinkercad to create some 3D models. We all got to grips with it really well and even managed to design and make a 3D model of a house. Our focus for this term is going to be climate action. We started off by learning about carbon footprints and we have now all made a pledge to help reduce our own footprints. We'll check in at the end of term to see if we've managed to keep up our pledges. We have a busy term ahead with Year 6 SATs and lots of

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writing to do, but we are looking forward to making the most of the sunshine in our wonderful outdoor spaces as well as our upcoming residential in Borrowdale!
