#### **SATS**

It is that time of year for formal assessments. Well done to our amazing Year 6s for completing their SATs this week! They have all been working so hard and they definitely deserved a treat. They got to pick their books for the end of year present from the SSA and then we went to a cafe for a sweet treat. Thank you to all the parents that joined us and congratulations to our Year 6s and Miss Plant!



The year 2 will be doing their SATs over the next couple of weeks. These will be carried out in small groups with the class teacher and formal assessments with be also be supported by teacher judgement and all the hard work that they have done all year!

After May half term, year 1 will be sitting the Phonics Screening check. This is carried out 1:1 with the class and Year 4s have the Multiplication Check. This is a short online test.

You can support your child by making sure they are well rested when they come into school and by going on the online platforms: Reading Eggs (particularly fast phonics for Year 1s), math seeds and times table Rockstarts, to make sure they have those basic skills to support them with their assessments. If you have any questions, just ask the class teachers.
